

TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR D.A.S.E. LIMITED

Amended and Restated: 03 June 2026

Welcome to D.A.S.E. Limited. By accessing or using our services, you agree to comply with and be bound by the following terms and conditions. These terms are governed by the laws of the United Kingdom and reflect the latest aviation, media production, and commercial standards.

1. Definitions

- "Company" refers to D.A.S.E. Limited (Registered in Scotland).
- "Services" refers to all professional aerial and ground-based operations provided by the Company, including but not limited to aerial photogrammetry, thermal inspections, infrastructure surveying, ground-based corporate media production, industrial cinematography, and high-resolution asset photography.
- "Client" refers to any individual or corporate entity engaging the Company for its Services.
- "Products" refers to all datasets, raw imagery, processed 3D models, and video outputs generated from our Services.

2. Regulatory Compliance

All operations are conducted in strict accordance with the UK Civil Aviation Authority (CAA) regulations. As of January 1, 2026, the Company confirms full compliance with Remote ID broadcasting requirements and UK Class Marking standards for all deployed unmanned aircraft systems (UAS).

3. Service Specification: Multi-Environment Media & Data Acquisition

D.A.S.E. Limited provides comprehensive multi-environment media and data acquisition, including:

- Aerial photography, videography, and drone surveying (data only).

- High-fidelity ground cinematography and executive corporate media production utilising advanced full-frame camera systems.
- Inspections of structures, asset mapping, and industrial land verification.
- Supply of digital products generated from our multi-cam processing pipelines.

4. Structural Provisions and Data Limitations

- No Professional Analysis: The Company provides raw data and processed visualisations only. We do not provide engineering, architectural, or legal reports.
- Client Responsibility: It is the sole responsibility of the Client or their appointed professionals (e.g., Chartered Surveyors, Structural Engineers) to interpret the data and certify any resulting reports or conclusions. The Company accepts no liability for any subsequent professional interpretations or engineering conclusions derived from the datasets provided.

5. Booking and Commercial Terms

- All deployments must be confirmed via a written Purchase Order or signed Service Agreement.
- Invoices are issued upon completion of data acquisition. Payment is due upon receipt unless alternative credit terms have been agreed in writing.

6. Cancellation and Weather Protocols

- Standard Cancellations: Must be made at least 48 hours in advance to avoid a deployment fee.
- Pilot Authority (Adverse Weather): In accordance with CAA safety standards, the Remote Pilot in Command (RPIC) holds absolute authority to cancel or reschedule a flight due to adverse weather, technical safety margins, or airspace restrictions.
- Rescheduling: Flights or ground deployments postponed due to safety or weather conditions will be rescheduled at the earliest mutually convenient window without additional penalty or secondary claims for consequential losses.

7. Liability and Insurance

- Negligence Carve-out: Nothing in these Terms shall limit or exclude the Company's liability for death or personal injury resulting from its negligence, as required under the Unfair Contract Terms Act 1977 (UCTA).
- General Limitation: Subject to the above, the Company's total liability for any claim arising from its services shall be strictly limited to the total amount paid by the Client for those specific services.
- Insurance: The Company maintains commercial drone liability insurance compliant with (EU) Regulation 785/2004.

8. Intellectual Property and Licensing

- Ownership: All intellectual property rights, master datasets, and high-bitrate source media produced remain the property of D.A.S.E. Limited.
- Commercial Licence: Upon full payment of the contractual billing invoice, the Client is granted a non-exclusive, perpetual licence to use the Products for their intended commercial and marketing purposes.
- Restriction: Use of Company-branded artwork, proprietary video frames, or trademarked assets outside of the delivered project scope requires explicit written consent.

9. Privacy and Data Protection

The Company complies with UK GDPR. We do not retain Client personal details beyond what is necessary for service delivery and statutory billing purposes.
